### FAMILY PROMISE

Family Promise of Harrisburg Capital Region (FPHCR) is a local non-profit organization that provides shelter for homeless children and their families in houses of faith overnight. The guests use the address of the Day Center for their mailing address. This is where the children are picked up for school, guests depart/arrive from work, conduct housing and employment searches and receive case management services.

The Day Center has relocated to 525 Hummel Avenue in Lemoyne. Beginning in February, we will be in need of Day Center volunteers to answer the telephone, take messages, interact with guests and provide general oversight when the Network Director is not available. Training will be provided.
