EUCCHARISTIC LAY VISITATION

We have had tremendous success with the Eucharistic Lay Visitation Program. It has been a very meaningful program both for the lay visitors and the home bound. This is a program whereby trained lay visitors take already consecrated communion elements out to the home bound. The lay visitors use a service from the Lutheran Occasional Service Book written especially for this kind of ministry. It is based on the election of seven men chosen to similarly assist the disciples in Acts 6:1-6.

Recently there has been additional interest in another class to train the Eucharistic Lay Visitors. The class takes about two hours. The actual service requires the visitation of eight to ten home bound every four to six months. Everyone is welcome to the class. The decision to be a Eucharistic Lay Visitor can be made after taking the class and in consultation with the pastor. Please contact the pastor at 332-4245 if you are interested.
